Anthony Bishop is Assistant Professor of Instructional Design for the Borough of Manhattan Community College's library. He has assessed online library instruction for a variety of courses, including nursing, composition, criminal justice, business, and public speaking. He is currently completing a doctorate in E-Learning, and he teaches a course called Assessment of Online Library Instruction for ALA's Research and User Services (RUSA) division.

Sara Lowe is the Associate Dean for Educational Services at Indiana University–Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI). She is also a co-creator and co-facilitator of ACRL's Assessment in Action RoadShow. She has published widely on assessment practices and projects, and she formerly served as the Assessment Officer and Librarian at Claremont Colleges Library.
